The Faculty of Law, University of Zagreb, has the honor to organize the **Transport Law *de lege ferenda*: 2nd Annual Young Academics' Vision on Tomorrow's Transport Law** conference.

This annual event has been inaugurated in 2013 in Leuven, Belgium, organized and hosted by the Catholic University Leuven. The speakers, young academics starting with, working on, or having finished their doctoral studies, had the opportunity to share the current or final results of their research, and participate in live debates on important transport law issues. The key goal of the TRANSLAWFER 2014 Conference is to continue the initiative, with hopes that the Conference becomes an annual event, hosted by Universities all over the World.

The presentations will be divided into a number of panels, each moderated by professors, practitioners and representatives from the transport and insurance industries. The moderators will introduce the subject-matter and moderate the discussion following each presentation. This method successfully connects the Academia with Practice, giving a better understanding of different perspectives concerning a particular topic of interest, and deepening the discourse between the two.
